Lesson 1: Activities and lifestyle [Synchronous] Specific Learning objectives: State how our activities and lifestyle change in each season. Specific Intended Learning Outcomes: Know that seasonal changes affect the way we dress, what we do, the time we spend outdoors and what we eat. Can understand a few features of each season. Realize that we spend more time outdoors in autumn and spring but not so much in summer and winter.

Assessment Criteria/Essential questions: Support : What do you wear to go to the beach? Stretch : What are the kinds of activities you prefer in summer?
