

PORTION FOR ENGLISH – YEAR 2
FIRST TERM EXAM -JAN 2022

Children will be assessed for reading comprehension, grammatical awareness, spelling and writing skills.

READING QUIZ on the 2 books allocated (10 marks)

ENGLISH READING: (40 Marks)

Comprehension questions will be set on an extract from an unseen fiction and non-fiction texts.

Questions will focus on:

- Deducing and inferring ideas/ information/meanings to answer comprehension questions.
- Expressing likes and dislikes about characters, character's feelings, setting, ideas in stories
- Vocabulary- meanings of words and phrases
- Sequencing events in the correct order.
- Identifying statements as true or false

ENGLISH WRITING: (50 Marks)

Part 1: Spelling (5 marks)

For **spelling test**, the teacher will read the words/paragraph twice and the children will write.

Part 2: Grammatical awareness (13 marks)

- Using punctuations- capital letters, full stops, exclamations and question marks.
- Types of sentences (statements, commands, questions and exclamations/ exclamatory sentences).

- Nouns- common and proper nouns, singular/ plural
- Pronouns (I and we).
- Verbs
- Adjectives
- Determiners (a, an, the, some).
- Compound words

Part 3 – Two writing tasks will be set. (12 + 20 marks)

- Story
- Recount
- Descriptive writing (place/ person /thing)
- Information text -Report writing

Marks will be given for:

- Interesting ideas, description, use of suitable vocabulary
- Organising the story or recount with beginning, middle and end
- Organising an information text/ report - Title, Subheadings Illustration, and factual information
- Punctuating sentences, using capital letters, full stops, commas, speech marks and question marks
- Sentence structure - Correct spelling, accurate tenses of the verbs, accurate use of grammar
- Handwriting
