## **READING - Reading Sections**

# Range of short and long answer questions will focus on:

- **selecting details, information** from the texts
- explaining with reference to the text to support inferences/points of view/opinions
- **exploring language features and their effects** (e.g. use of figurative language such as simile, personification, metaphor; long and short sentences; types of sentences; nouns, noun phrases, adjectives, verbs, adverbs, adverbial phrases; words and phrases; modals; conditional)
- **analysing structural devices** (title, punctuations; paragraphs, headings, subheadings) with relevance to the development of the texts
- identifying and explaining author's purpose and viewpoints
- **analysing** author's range of vocabulary to convey messages, moods, feelings and attitudes
- long response question **explaining how successfully the** writer describes ideas, themes, events, situations or settings; expressing critical opinions with examples from the given extract.
- long response question that requires finding similarities between two texts with examples.

## READING ASSESSMENT OBJECTIVES Focus on : AO1, AO2 and AO4

- **AO1:** Identify and interpret explicit and implicit information and ideas
- **AO2:** Comment on, explain, and analyse how writers use language and structure to achieve effects and influence readers, using relevant subject terminology to support their views
