Students will be assessed for reading comprehension, grammatical awareness, spelling and writing skills.

English Reading:

(30 marks)

Comprehension questions will be set on extracts from **unseen** fiction and non-fiction texts:

Questions will focus on:

- Identifying key ideas from text
- Deducing and inferring ideas
- Meaning of words through context clues
- Describing characters and Sequencing ideas/events in the text
- Summarizing key ideas and making predictions
- Supporting and explaining answers with appropriate evidence
- Justifying answers with evidence from the text
- Identifying facts and opinion
- Identifying the genre of a text e.g. narrative fiction
- Language Features of text types

English Writing:

Part 1: Grammatical Awareness

(10 marks)

It tests language skills in grammar, spelling, vocabulary and punctuation.

- Identify suffixes, prefixes
- Grammatical vocabulary (nouns, verbs, adjectives and adverbs)
- Recognizing Fronted Adverbials and Verb phrases

- Noun phrases/prepositional phrases
- Active/Passive Voice
- Perfect Tenses
- Relative Pronouns/Relative Clauses
- Demonstratives
- Imperatives

Part 2: Writing Task

(20 marks)

Students have to attempt one writing task. The writing task may require adaptation of style and form of writing according to purpose and audience.

Forms of Writing

- * Short Story
- * Recount
- * Information Text
- * Writing Instructions
- * Explanation Text
- * Letter Writing
- * Diary Entries

Marks will be given for:

- Development of a range of ideas; variety of information, descriptive details, awareness of audience or purpose
- Title and organization of ideas and paragraph/sentence structure
- Use of punctuation, grammar and spelling
- Handwriting
