

Grading of New GCSEs from 2017



The New, reformed GCSEs specification, will be sat by our Year 11 students during June 2018 for Mathematics, English Language & English Literature. These GCSEs will be graded numerically from 9-1, where 9 being the highest and 1 the lowest, instead of A*to G. Our current Year 11 students will therefore have grades 9-1 alongside the traditional grades A*- G in their other subject areas. By 2019 there will be reformed GCSEs / IGSCs and new grading in all subjects.

The following information is taken from the Department for Education U.K explaining the new grading system 9-1.

Broadly the same proportion of students will achieve a grade 4 and above as currently achieve a grade C and above

Broadly the same proportion of students will achieve a grade 7 and above as currently achieve a grade A and above

Broadly the same proportion of students will achieve a grade 1 and above as currently achieve a grade G and above GCSE,
