- Analyzing language, form and structure used by the writer to convey character, events, ideas, themes and viewpoints so as to to convey the social and cultural context of the stories in the selection.

SECTION B

Poetry: [unseen poems]

Marks: 18

Questions will focus on:

- Reading to infer, interpreting and deducing details from the unseen poems
- Identifying and describing key points, themes, authors’ purpose and viewpoints
- Commenting on the form and structure, and the poets’ use of language along with identifying and explaining poetic features such as metaphor, simile, personification, use of contrast , rhyme and rhythm.

NOTE: Reviewing units/ topics taught; worksheets, class work / homework activities; assessments, tests will be a good preparation for the examination.
