FIRST REPORT DAY: As communicated to you in our previous circular, the first Parent Teacher meeting day has been scheduled for Thursday, 28th November from 10:30 am until 2:00 pm. Your child's first assessment report may be accessed via the SIMS Parent App and no printed copies will be issued. We regret that we will not be able to publish reports of students with any outstanding fees.
