Lesson 1	<p>Lesson Objective: Revising the difference between saying you do something and you like to do something.</p> <p>To say you are doing something in French, you simply conjugate the verb in the person intended.</p> <p>e.g, to say I play or I am playing Je joue</p> <p>To say we go or we are going Nous allons</p> <p>To say she sings or she is singing Elle chante.</p> <p>To say you like to do something is a little different. You MUST conjugate the verb to like, in the intended person, and the next verb Must be in the infinitive form of the verb.</p> <p>e.g. To say you like to play J'aime jouer</p> <p>To say we like to go Nous aimons aller</p> <p>To say she likes to sing Elle aime chanter</p>
