- To showcase Emirati hospitality, coffee was offered in the pavilion.

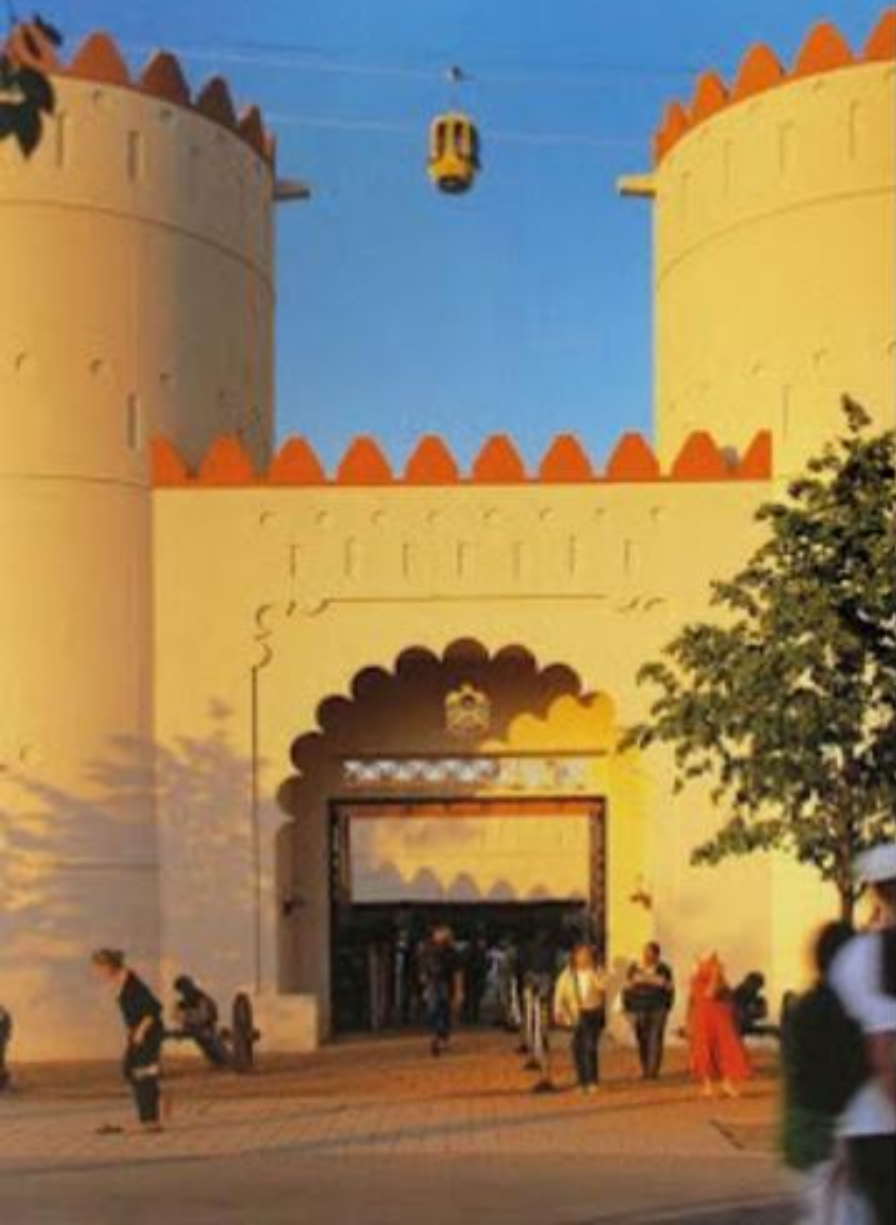


1992 SEVILLE, SPAIN

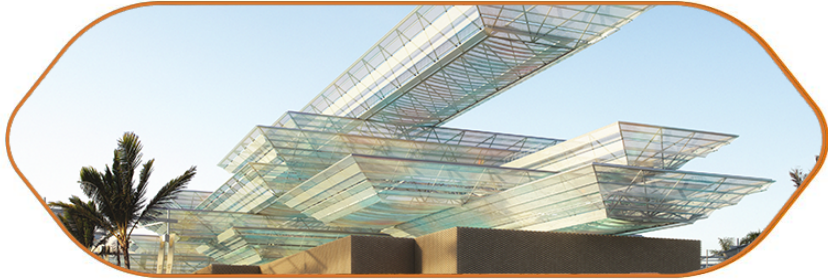

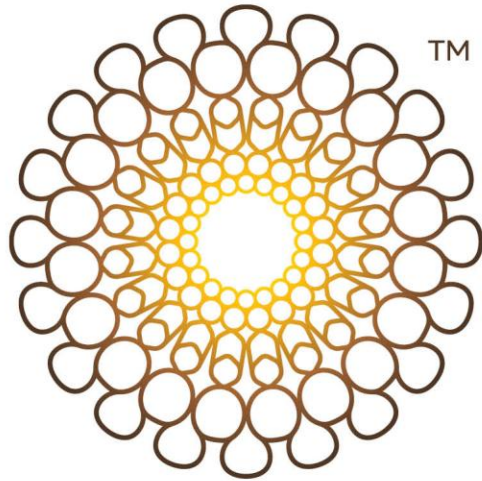
