<b>Task</b>	<p><b>Learning objective</b> – Explore title, book cover and details of Chapter 1</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Reading chapter 1 out loud</li> <li>- Sharing ideas about the book cover</li> <li>- Discussing main ideas/setting of the novel</li> <li>- Discussing first impressions of the characters</li> </ul>

<b>Task</b>	<p><b>Learning objectives :</b></p> <p>Identify main ideas with details from the novel          Find meanings of new words as used in Chapter 1          Make notes during discussions</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Finding meanings of new words in the given chapter</li> <li>- Understanding the feelings and thoughts of the different characters</li> <li>- Discussing the key events/details in chapter 1</li> </ul>
