Artwork Theme

The students are welcome to submit artwork against the theme of Dubai, in landscape/portrait form as the frames are suitable for both and can be framed in either format.

Students can take the following example as a guideline:

- Dubai Milestones: Burj Khalifa, Burj Al Arab, Dubai Metro, Water Canal, Museum of the Future
- Mission to Mars
- How do you imagine Dubai in the next 10 years?
- Memories of Mudish
- Memories of Dubai Shopping Festival

• Take a digital photograph of your artwork. Save your digital photo at the largest size possible that does not exceed 1 MB. For example, a 5" x 7" digital photograph of your artwork should be large enough for judges to see detail while still being smaller than 1 MB. If your digital image is larger than 1 MB, you can use a photo editing program (such as Photoshop or Microsoft Office Picture Manager) to resize it by either lowering the

resolution (DPI) or by shrinking the image dimensions.

You can also change the settings on your scanner or digital camera to create an image with a lower resolution.

Use the following settings:

• Quality: Normal

• Max Width: 85.5 cm

• Max length: 120.5 cm

3. Save your digital image as a .jpg using the following file name and type:

4. Share your artwork on dsfartcomp@dubaitourism.ae. Your artwork must be uploaded no later than November 19th to be eligible for the competition.
