Lesson 1 ZOOM	Topic: Fiction – Fantastic, Funny, Frightening-“ Water, Water, Water!”
Task	Learning objectives – <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read and discuss initial understanding of a story • Summarize a story in own words. <p>Read the story (aloud).Discuss about genre of the story- Humour. Identify the key events in the story. Discuss and write summary in their own words using the key events in <i>Water, Water, Water!</i></p>

Task	Learning objectives : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Explore characterization • Provide reasoned justifications for your views. <p>Discuss the impression of the character and identify the main events in ‘<i>Thank Goodness</i>’.</p>

Lesson 3 ASYNCHRONOUS	Topic: Fiction – Fantastic, Funny, Frightening- Water, Water, Water!” and ‘Thank Goodness!’
Task	Learning objectives : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make comparisons within the two stories. • Support viewpoints giving suitable reasons. <p>Complete the questions on “Fiction – Fantastic, Funny, Frightening-“ Water, Water, Water!” and ‘Thank Goodness!’ on GC.</p>
