Dear Parents,

Greetings from Saint Mary's. As we reach the end of what has been a very surreal 2020 we would like to wish you all a safe, blessed and peaceful Winter Break. We pray that the spirit of the season fills your hearts and homes with love, joy, happiness and the special warmth of family. Knowing that many of you might not opt to travel at the moment, we hope that you will find the much needed time to connect virtually with family at this festive time of the year.

WINTER BREAK:

The school will be closed for the Winter Break from **Sunday**, 13th

December until Thursday, 31st December 2020 and we return to lessons on Sunday, 3rd January 2021. The school office will also be closed on all these days. The school office will be open on Saturday, 12th December from 8:00 am until 1:00 pm and we would encourage you to use this time to collect any

documents that you need to collect.

In order for the school to be compliant with the UAE Covid-19 travel requirements, please click on the official DHA link (available on website) and answer the relevant questions even if your child is not travelling. We appreciate if you are not travelling that you complete it as soon as possible. If you are travelling, please complete it prior to your child's return to lessons on 3rd January 2021.

SOCIAL STUDIES EXAM FROM MOE FOR YEARS 2 TO 13:

We were informed yesterday that ALL students from years two through thirteen are required to do a centralised Social Studies Exam mandated by the Ministry of Education (MOE) tomorrow, 10th December 2020. Our class teachers met with their classes today at the end of the day to give children further information on the steps to login and do the exam. They will also email each child his/her unique password for this purpose. The MOE has strongly advised against the use of tabs as additional software has to be downloaded and so we would request your help to have you child complete it on your laptop before 7:00 pm tomorrow as the link expires at 8:00 pm. Children with access to a desktop or a laptop will be doing it together between 8:00 and 9:00 am tomorrow morning. **Children who have any Wifi issues can do it anytime of the day before 8:00 pm**.

SURVEY FOR DISTANCE OR BLENDED LEARNING FOR TERM TWO FROM 28TH IANUARY 2021:

We will be sending you'll a reminder of the protocols to read through on Saturday, 12th December 2020 and once you are all reminded of the same, we will require every parent to fill out a form with your choice for the mode of learning for your child for the second term and you will need to sign the form, scan it and email it as an attachment to your child's class teacher. Please read the protocols very carefully so that you can make an informed decision. *The deadline for sending this form back to your child's class teacher is 5th January 2021.*

FIRST TERM EXAMINATIONS 13TH TO 27TH JANUARY 2021:

We have uploaded the First Term Examination Time Table to the school website and have attached the same to this circular. Please read on about further information related to examinations.

Year 4:

For English Language, English Literature, Math, Arabic, Islamic Studies, Social Studies, Science,
History, Computing, Moral Education, French, we will use Google Forms
and exams will be out of 50 marks and 1 hour or 1 hour 30 minutes
duration. For Geography, Music, Bible, Citizenship and PSHE, there
will be a project-based task for 25 marks that will be
converted to 100. Art – a themed piece will be given
for 25 marks and this will be converted to 100. (The

Music and Art assignment and guidelines will be given before the winter break) Project tasks

will not include videos and will be based on what children can achieve on their own with minimal or no assistance from parents. Please ensure that your child has a digital device (laptop/desktop/tablet) that is in good working condition for the exams.

Years 5 & 6:

For English Language, English Literature, Math, Arabic, Islamic Studies, Social Studies, Science, History, Computing, Moral Education, French, Geography, Citizenship & Bible, we will use Google Forms and papers will be out of 50 marks and 1 hour duration. For Music, there will be a project-based task for 25 marks that will be converted to 100. Art – a themed piece will be given for 25 marks and this will be converted to 100. (The Art and Music assignment and guidelines will be given before the winter break) Project tasks will not include videos and will be based on what children can achieve on their own with no assistance from parents. Please ensure that your child has a digital device (laptop/desktop/tablet) that is in good working condition for the exams.

Years 7 through 13:

For secondary school we will not be using Google Forms but students will receive their examination question paper and they will be required to write the answers just as they would on ruled paper sheets and scan it as a PDF document and send it to a specially created GOOGLE CLASSROOM for Examinations. There will be a separate time allocated after the exam for students to scan and post their answer scripts. Full details of the process will be sent to you and to the children in January. It is imperative that children have a good supply of good quality ruled paper and a digital device that works well so as not to hamper their work. Please ensure that you have a good and stable Wifi connection for the examinations. A desktop or laptop is preferable to a tablet.

Portions for the First Term Exams:

All portions for the First Term examinations have been uploaded under the relevant Department section of the school website.

Revision for the First Term Exams:

Although some revision might be put into Google Classroom, there is no expectation that it has to be done in the Winter Break and teachers will go through this revision in January. We are providing it earlier for those parents who might wish to do some revision work during the break. However students who will be sitting their board examinations are expected and encouraged to make use of this time to revise previously taught material from years nine and ten and to practice material from past papers.



PDF Reading book assigned in Google Classroom for years 4 through 10:

One book will be assigned for children to read during the Winter Break and a quiz on these will be conducted after the exams and the marks will be integrated into the examination for English Language. Reading is the most valuable skill and we would like to embed this skill in every child, so your support in encouraging them to read with interest will be greatly appreciated.

ADMISSION FORMS FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2021-2022:

We would like to inform all parents that admissions to the Academic Year 2021-2022 are now open. There will be NO ADMISSIONS FOR YEAR ELEVEN. Please note that Second term fees must be paid between the 1st and 31st of January 2021. All fees must be paid on time and via the SKIPLY APP.

Please be informed that the GLCAT4 report for your child will be sent to the SIMS PARENT APP.

COMPETITION AND PROGRAMME PARTICIPATION UNDER DL SECTION OF OUR WEBSITE:

We would like to invite you to please check this new section we have added for many interesting programmes and competitions that the children can participate in.

REFUND FOR ARABIC/ ISLAMIC STUDIES/ MORAL EDUCATION BOOKS AND COLLECTION OF SOCIAL STUDIES TEXT BOOKS UPDATED LINK:

We have uploaded a refreshed link on the school website for the purpose of booking an appointment with Iris International for refunds.

BLENDED LEARNING CRITICAL AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE REQUIRED:

If any child who has opted for Blended Learning shows symptoms of Covid-19, they must be kept at home and a diagnosis must be sought from an approved medical practitioner. The parent must email Ms. Lise-Ann on l.pinto-smchs@smgeducation.org and inform her of the status and send a copy of a PCR test that has been conducted. In addition in case a child or a parent, sibling or any family member of a child who has opted for Blended Learning, tests POSITIVE for COVID-19, an email must be sent to Ms. Lise-Ann without delay and the child must be kept at home to self isolate for 14 days. These are critical DHA requirements and as the Health and Safety Officer of the School, Ms. Lise-Ann will then contact the parents of any other child who was in contact with the child in question as well as staff members who will also have to self isolate for 14 days as part of contact tracing requirements. A PCR Negative test for a child who previously tested positive is also required in addition to the 14 day isolation in order for the child to return to school.

DISTANCE LEARNING CRITICAL AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE REQUIRED:

Even if a child who has opted for Distance Learning has tested positive for Covid-19, parents are requested to please inform Lise-Ann via an email, clearly stating your child's full name, class and section, Emirates ID number, date of birth, home address and parent's mobile number. This is because DHA contacts Ms. Lise-Ann both via telephone and email requesting this information and often it is during late hours in the evening or at night and so this information from you would greatly assist the process with DHA.
