FIRST TERM EXAM –JANUARY 2021

Children will be assessed for reading comprehension, grammatical awareness, spelling and writing skills.

ENGLISH READING:

(40 marks)

Comprehension questions will be set on an extract from an unseen fiction and non-fiction text.

Questions will focus on:

- Deducing and inferring ideas/ information/meanings to answer comprehension questions.
- Expressing likes and dislikes about character, character's feelings, setting, ideas in Stories
- Vocabulary- meanings of words and phrases.
- Sequencing events in the correct order.
- Identifying statements as true or false

ENGLISH WRITING:

(40 marks)

Part 1: Grammatical awareness

- Using punctuations- capital letters, full stops, exclamations and question marks.
- Types of sentences (statement, command, questions and exclamations/ exclamatory sentences).
- Nouns- common and proper nouns, singular/ plural
- Pronouns (I and we)
- Verbs
- Adjectives
- Determiners (a, an, the, some).
- Compound words

Part 2 - One writing task will be set.

- Story
- Recount
- Descriptive writing (place/ person /thing)
- Information text -Report writing

Marks will be given for:

- Interesting ideas, description, use of suitable vocabulary
- Organising the story or recount with beginning, middle and end
- Organising an information text/ report Title, Subheadings Illustration, and factual information
- Punctuating sentences, using capital letters, full stops, commas, speech marks and question marks
- Sentence structure - Correct spelling, accurate tenses of the verbs, accurate use of grammar
- Handwriting
