YEAR 1-PORTION FOR ENGLISH FINAL EXAMINATION- MAY 2021

Children will be assessed for reading comprehension, grammatical awareness, spelling and writing skills.

ENGLISH READING:

Questions will be set on extracts from <u>unseen fiction and non -fiction texts</u>.

Questions will focus on:

- Selecting key ideas/ information/meanings to answer comprehension questions
- Predicting what happens next in a simple story or sequence of events
- Expressing likes and dislikes with reference to character, setting, ideas in stories
- Multiple choice questions that focus on characters, main ideas, settings
- Vocabulary- meanings of words and phrases
- Sequencing events in the correct order
- Identifying statements as true or false; yes or no
- Identifying nouns, verbs, adjectives, proper and common nouns, singular and plurals (adding -s / -es); suffixes (-ed / -ing), indefinite articles (a / an)

ENGLISH WRITING:

Spelling test

a. For **Spelling Test**, the teacher will read the sentences twice. The children write the correct spelling of the missing word the third time the teacher reads the sentence.

b. Writing:

Writing tasks will be set for:

- Writing sentence caption
- Descriptive writing
- Sequencing pictures in order and write story ideas into story title, beginning, middle and end
- Writing Information Report

- Alphabetical order
- Jumbled sentences
- Identifying nouns, verbs, adjectives, proper and common nouns, singular and plurals (adding -s / -es) suffixes (-ed / -ing), Indefinite Articles (a / an)
- Punctuation (capital letter, exclamation mark, question mark and full stops)

Marks will be given for:

- \Box Interesting ideas, description, suitable vocabulary
- \Box Organising story ideas into story title, beginning, middle and end
- □ Punctuating sentences, using capital letters, question mark, exclamation mark and full stops
- \Box Correct spelling
- □ Handwriting
