**ENGLISH READING:**

**Comprehension questions will be set on extracts from unseen fiction and non-fiction texts.**

**Comprehension questions will be set on:**

- Identifying key ideas from text
- Deducing and inferring ideas /information/meaning to answer questions
- Meanings of words through context clues
- Sequencing ideas/events in the text
- Summarizing key ideas
- Supporting and explaining answers with appropriate evidence
- Justifying answers with evidence from the text
- Expressing likes and dislikes with evidence from the text (personal response)
- Locating facts and opinion
- Features of different text types
