	who is active within and
	contributes to their community.
	Ask students to think of ways in which they are good citizens -
	ask for suggestions
	from the class. Then ask them to think of things they could do
Resources	better - again, ask for
	suggestions from the class.
	Then ask students to write three examples of each that are true
	for them personally.

	and three things that you could do better.
