Lesson 1	<p>Learning objective: Understand that objects can be seen when light is reflected off them.</p> <p>Learning outcome: By the end of the lesson-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Understand that objects can be seen when light is reflected off them. ➤ Explain that shiny objects/materials are not light sources but reflects light. ➤ Distinguish between light sources and light reflectors ➤ Understand that reflectors can be seen only when light shines on it. ➤ Explain why it is important to wear suitable things in poor visibility in order to be seen. ➤ Notice that light is reflected from surfaces.
