Learning Outcomes:	By the end of this week, students can: (1) Explain in own words what is meant by fairness and unfairness (2) Identify a fair and an unfair situation and even reason out ways to avoid such situations.
Lesson	<p><u>Learning objectives:</u></p> <p>(1) Give a simple explanation of what is meant by fairness and unfairness</p> <p>(2) Recognise a fair and an unfair situation.</p> <p>1. Discuss the story: ‘Rashid Realises His Mistake’.</p> <p>2. Elicit the value understood from the story through oral questioning and activities</p> <p>Which of the given situation is fair and which one is unfair?</p> <p>Oral task 1: Did you say sorry to your parents or brother or sister yesterday or today? Describe the situation.</p> <p>Oral task 2: Read and answer this situation. Only 4 children can play in this game. You and your friends are already in a group of four. Your classmate comes late and wishes to join in this game. Think of a fair solution that will allow your friend to be a part of this game.</p> <p>Notebook Task 1: Find 2 or 3 synonyms for the word - <u>sorry</u>.</p> <p>Notebook Task 2: Draw the picture of the fair ending of the story.</p>
