Lesson 1	Topic: THE EMPATHY CIRCLE
Task	<p>Learning objective -</p> <p><i>f</i> . Describe what it feels like to be truly listened to</p> <p><i>f</i> . List some positive differences we might see in the world if people really listened to one another</p> <p><i>f</i> . Share creative ideas for a ‘Majlis space’ at Expo 2020.</p> <p>Discussion shared on ZOOM:</p> <p>3 minutes</p> <p>What is Expo 2020?</p> <p><i>f</i> . Ask students what they know about Expo 2020 Dubai.</p> <p><i>f</i> . Can students name the Expo’s theme? (Connecting Minds, Creating the Future)</p> <p><i>f</i> . Can students name Expo’s three sub-themes? (Opportunity, Mobility and Sustainability)</p> <p><i>f</i> . Explain that each sub-theme will have its own pavilion at Expo 2020 – a unique building filled with exhibits and activities that bring the theme to life and show how each one is helping to create a better future.</p> <p><i>f</i> . Explain that Expo 2020 will showcase lots of ideas about how we can create a better future, not just in the UAE but around the world, to the 25 million visitors expected to come, and who can share their inspiration around the world.</p> <p><i>f</i> . If you have more time, use the Expo 2020 web link to explore more together.</p>
Resources	<p>Task-</p> <p><i>f</i> . Explain that students are going to practise active listening and learn what it means to be a good listener.</p> <p><i>f</i> . Ask students to form groups of four. Review the instructions on the Empathy Circle Guide Activities & Handouts sheet.</p> <p><i>f</i> . Groups take turns to share and be listened to, as they share their hopes and excitement about Expo 2020.</p> <p>Each student should speak for three minutes at most, so steps 1–3 take six minutes each.</p> <p>Outcome:</p> <p>Students will talk about the importance of being listened to and how does UAE follow that.</p> <p>-ZOOM</p>
