**To: The Parents of students in Years 1 - 13 : FIRST UPDATE FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2021-2022 - WELCOME BACK TO SCHOOL**

Dear Parents,

**Greetings from Saint Mary's Catholic High School.** We would like to offer right at the onset our most sincere prayers for those families of our bigger Marian family that have been affected by illness due to the Covid-19 pandemic as well as other related financial stress and anxiety. We would like to take this opportunity to welcome back our existing Marian family members and we warmly welcome all those children and parents who have joined our Marian Family this year. Please go through this update, albeit a long one, very carefully as it will give you a good insight into how we are moving forward with teaching and learning as well as give you other important information at the start of the new year.

**KHDA APPROVAL FOR DISTANCE LEARNING FOR THE WHOLE SCHOOL FROM 29<sup>TH</sup> AUGUST TO 1<sup>ST</sup> SEPTEMBER ( INCLUSIVE ) :**

We have received KHDA approval for the entire school to be on Distance Learning ( irrespective of the mode of learning chosen ) for the first four days of the coming week. **Thursday, 2<sup>nd</sup> September will be the first blended day of the year** and details about which students have to come in on Thursday will be communicated to your child's school email ID. We will be undertaking the mandatory and accredited deep cleaning, disinfection and sanitization of the entire premises, both internal and external and therefore we would like to then ventilate all the rooms and let everything dry out completely before welcoming children onsite. **THE SCHOOL PREMISES WILL BE COMPLETELY SHUT THIS SATURDAY.**

**NEW KHDA PROTOCOLS FOR FACE-TO -FACE LEARNING AT DUBAI PRIVATE SCHOOLS:**

On the night of Monday, 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2021, the KHDA issued completely new protocols for the new Academic Year , the most important implication of which is that **ALL STUDENTS MUST BE BACK TO SCHOOL FOR FACE-TO-FACE LEARNING BY 3<sup>RD</sup> OCTOBER 2021**, except in exceptional circumstances. In addition, from this academic year, **ONE METRE PHYSICAL DISTANCING** is recommended. Parents, guardians, or visitors who enter the school premises, including those

dropping off and picking up younger children, should provide **PROOF OF VACCINATION** or a **NEGATIVE PCR TEST** taken in the previous 48 hours. The KHDA detailed document of Protocols as well as a document on FAQs is available under the KHDA section on our school website [www.stmarysdubai.com](http://www.stmarysdubai.com). Please go through it carefully.

### **FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL, 29<sup>TH</sup> AUGUST 2021. WHAT WILL IT LOOK LIKE? :**

The 29<sup>th</sup> of August, 2021 will be **A DISTANCE LEARNING DAY** for the whole school. The first four lessons of the day will be set as time with the class teachers who will meet the children and give them various guidelines about all that they need to know about their lessons and how to access lesson links, discuss rules for the use of Zoom, Google Classroom, share lesson timings, class time table etc.

### **ORIENTATION FOR PARENTS OF NEW STUDENTS TO SMCHS FOR THIS ACADEMIC YEAR 2021-2022 ON SATURDAY, 28<sup>TH</sup> AUGUST @ 10:00 am. :**

There will be an orientation for parents of new students to the school on **Saturday, 28<sup>th</sup> August at 10:00 am**. A zoom link will be sent to your child's school email. For years 5 through 10, we would like the new students to also be present with their parents for this orientation. The focus of the orientation will be mainly on the important areas to be considered for the month of September. Another orientation will be held for every class in the third week of September with a focus on the considerations for the **MANDATED FACE-TO-FACE learning** from 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2021.

### **STUDENT SCHOOL EMAIL ID:**

Your child's school email will be a focal point for our communication to you. **We will use a parent's email only to communicate outstanding fee or disciplinary issues.** In the coming weeks we will be creating a **CLASS GROUP EMAIL** for every class. This is for the dissemination of information daily from the class teacher to the parents of this class and we request parents not to write back to this address. We recommend that every parent checks this email after 6:00 pm everyday for important updates. Every student will receive an email from IT support today and tomorrow with updated login details as well as the email ID of the class teacher/s.

### **BOOK DELIVERIES :**

Our book distributors will be commencing with distribution of books from the 5<sup>th</sup> of September 2021. We apologise for the slight delay due to delays with international shipments. Please be assured that our teachers will post all relevant teaching material in Google Classroom, even in the absence of text books and that the children will not miss out on anything in terms of their work. We highly recommend that **parents cover ALL BOOKS ( TEXT BOOKS AND NOTEBOOKS ) with a plastic laminate** so these can be wiped down with sanitizing wipes from time to time to minimize the chance of infections.

## **PAYMENT OF FIRST TERM FEES :**

*Students in year 12 will have to wait a few days more to pay the first term fees and we will let you know when the SKIPLY app is updated for you.*

The window for payment of the FIRST TERM FEES is between the 26<sup>th</sup> of August, 2021 and 30<sup>th</sup> September 2021. Fees that have not been paid by the 30<sup>th</sup> of September 2021 will be considered OUTSTANDING and commensurate actions will be applied as per regulator policy. We would like to remind ALL parents that timely fee payments are important for the sustained functioning of the school.

For fee payments please note the following points:

- 1) The fee structure for the academic year 2021-2022 has been put up on the school website
  - 2) As announced earlier, the re-registration fee of AED 500 paid earlier by the parents to confirm the seat for the new session for their wards will be adjusted with the 1st term fee. Parents should pay AED 500 less from the mentioned 1st term fee or the full term fee as the case maybe.
  - 3) The mode of payments to pay the fees are : credit card / company or manager's cheques / bank transfer / Skiplly (online payment portal/gateway)/ cash. Please note we discourage cash transactions for reasons of safety for one and all.
- A) **Skiplly:** please note that this is a payment gateway and is a service provided by RAK Bank. The tuition fee will not reflect the real time reducing balance of the fees paid.

To pay the fees through the Skiplly app, choose the option tuition fee. Under this option there are three categories of 1st term, 2nd term and Enter Amount. Please select "Enter Amount" and pay 1st term fee, after deducting AED 500 from the 1st term fee for the specific Year group. The table below will serve as an easy guide.

### **DAYS FOR BLENDED LEARNING FOR THOSE STUDENTS WHO HAVE OPTED FOR IT:**

Class teachers will send students a schedule of their dates for on-site learning for the month of September on Monday, 30<sup>th</sup> August 2021.

### **REMINDER OF PROTOCOLS FOR TERM ONE :**

Please be advised that since the KHDA released updated protocols on the 23<sup>rd</sup> of August 2021, *our own protocols released on the 22<sup>nd</sup> of August 2021 will now be applicable only for the month of September 2021* . We will send parents a detailed circular commensurate with latest protocols from the KHDA , later in the month of September , once we have made accommodations for the new changes in protocols.

### **GOOGLE CLASSROOM:**

Class teachers and subject teachers will be adding students to their respective Google Classrooms over the weekend. Zoom links, reference material, homework assignments, teaching and learning material will be posted in Google Classroom and this will continue to be of critical importance even when we resume face-to-face learning from 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2021.

### **UNIFORMS:**

Students on Distance Learning do not need to wear the school uniform but must be dressed neatly and modestly. Students coming in for blended learning on particular days will need to wear the school uniform from the month of October 2021.

Girls uniforms and the boys' navy blue trousers are available for purchase from our distributors , IRIS and they may be contacted on 04-3966615 for Dubai and on 06-5444500 for Sharjah.

The boys white polo t-shirts, the sports uniforms and the winter hoodies will have to be purchased from the school.

Students coming in for blended learning will be allowed to wear coloured clothes for the month of September 2021 and the following guidelines must be adhered to for both boys and girls.

- Full Jeans will be allowed – dark blue or black only and jeans must not be torn or distressed in any way.
- Plain t-shirts or shirts for boys.
- Plain t-shirts or blouses for girls ( FULL MODESTY is expected )
- Full Jeans will be allowed for girls– dark blue or black only and jeans must not be torn or distressed in any way.
- Skirts below the knee ( when sitting )
- Salwar kameez.
- Black sports shoes for boys and white sports shoes for girls
- NO LONG HAIR FOR BOYS AND NO COLOURED HAIR/ HAIR TINTS/ HAIR HIGHLIGHTS FOR GIRLS. Any coloured hair will have to be dyed back to its original colour if a child is coming in for on- site lessons.
- No nail polish or make up.

### **PURCHASE OF UNIFORMS FROM SCHOOL:**

Please read through the guidelines very carefully and please note that the dates set aside for year groups must be strictly adhered to.

- a) Only **ONE PARENT OR GUARDIAN** will be allowed on the premises to purchase the school uniform. Parents, guardians, or visitors who enter the school premises, should provide **PROOF OF VACCINATION** or a **NEGATIVE PCR TEST** taken in the previous 48 hours. Temperature screening will also be applicable and anyone with a temperature of 37.5 degrees or higher will be denied entry.
- b) Please carry your own approximate measurement of a similar polo t-shirt and track pants with you.
- c) Uniforms once purchased cannot be returned, therefore please be sure of the size you are buying.
- d) Sample sizes will be hung on display as a visual guide.
- e) Payment only by debit or credit card. **STRICTLY NO CASH.**
- f) The security guard will give parents a token and parents will be called according to that serial order. Please anticipate a waiting time.

g) We will do our best to assist with purchases for siblings but we request your patience as waiting times may be longer.

### **TRAVEL DECLARATION:**

In order for the school to be compliant with the UAE Covid-19 travel requirements, please click on the official DHA link ( available on website ) and answer the relevant questions even if your child has not travelled. This form is **MANDATORY and has to be filled for ALL STAFF and STUDENTS TEN DAYS PRIOR TO THE RE-OPENING OF SCHOOL.** The email required to be filled in the field on the form is [traveldecl-smchs@smgeducation.org](mailto:traveldecl-smchs@smgeducation.org)

### **CRITICAL AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE REQUIRED IF ANY STUDENT TESTS POSITIVE, EVEN AT THE WEEKEND:**

If any child shows symptoms of Covid-19, they must be kept at home and a diagnosis must be sought from an approved medical practitioner. **If a child tests positive, the parent must use the link on the school website and fill out the required details and upload a copy of a PCR test that has been conducted. These are critical DHA requirements and have to be treated with the utmost seriousness.** The school will then contact the parents of any other child who was in contact with the child in question as well as staff members who will also have to self isolate for 10 days as part of contact tracing requirements. ***A DHA Clearance Certificate for a child who previously tested positive is also required in order for the child to return to school.*** In addition in case a child or a parent, sibling or any family member of a child tests POSITIVE for COVID-19, an email must be sent to Ms. Lise-Ann and Dr. Dayani without delay and the child, by virtue of being a close contact, must be kept at home to self isolate for 10 days.

### **WEEKLY LESSON PLANS:**

Every Saturday, we will upload the lesson plans for the week so that you will know in advance of the week what your child is going to be learning in the week to come. These plans can be found under the relevant departments on the school website. This will commence from 4<sup>th</sup> September since we will be doing baseline revision during week one.

### **SIMS PARENT APP/ ACTIVE LEARN:**

Please note that these are still in process and our IT Support will be sending out the invitation and credentials for the same in some time. We will let you know via a circular when that process gets rolled out. Kindly do not email IT Support for this at the moment.

### **READING CHECK FOR NEW ADMISSIONS TO YEARS ONE THROUGH FOUR:**

A simple check for age appropriate reading will be conducted for ALL new admissions from years one through four. An appointment slot will be communicated to you via the student's school email ID. This assessment is to gauge whether the student requires additional support to gain age appropriate reading skills. Kindly ensure that your child is well prepared and ready to display his/her reading

skills to an adult for a 15 minute time slot. The student support services team will get in touch with you via the student school email ID to schedule a time for this.

**BOARD EXAMINATION FEES:**

**We would like you to be informed well in advance that EDEXCEL LONDON BOARD EXAMINATION FEES will be collected in the month of NOVEMBER 2021 for students in years ELEVEN and THIRTEEN. We trust that this will help you to budget accordingly. You can check your KHDA Parent-School contract for the BOARD EXAM FEE AMOUNT for each year group.**

Re: **CLARIFICATIONS REGARDING UNIFORM POLICY FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2021 - 2022**

Dear Parents,

Please read through the Uniform Policy carefully.

## **SCHOOL UNIFORM**

### **Girls' Shirt:**

All girls will continue to wear the light blue blouse with the school logo. **We request parents to kindly make sure that the size selected for your daughter is appropriate with a slightly looser fit for a more modest appearance.**

### **Girls' Skirt :**

Girls will also continue to wear the existing grey skirt, but we would appeal to all parents to make sure that the skirts purchased for your daughter, are worn modestly and are of appropriate length. ( must cover the knees while seated ). **It has been an unpleasant experience to have to constantly correct our young ladies for the often immodest length of their skirts and we strongly urge all parents to take strict cognizance of the same and to ensure that your daughters' skirts are well below the knee. Do take into account sudden gains in height when you purchase the skirts.**

### **Boys' Uniform :**

Boys will also continue to wear the white T-Shirt with the school logo and navy blue trousers.

### **Boys' and Girls' Sports Uniform :**

Boys in Primary School ( Years 1 through 6 ) will wear dark navy blue shorts or long tracks and a T-shirt in their respective house colours with the house logo on the back and the school logo in front. Primary school girls will wear dark navy blue track pants and a T-shirt in their respective house colours with the house logo on the back and the school logo in front. Students in Secondary school ( Years 7 through 13 ) will wear dark navy blue track pants and a T-shirt in their respective house colours with the house logo on the back and the school logo in front.

## **SHOES (GIRLS)**

GIRLS will be allowed to wear sports shoes ( ONLY FULL WHITE ) on the days they have sports and / or co-curricular activities. On other days, all girls MUST wear BLACK FORMAL LEATHER SHOES with GREY SOCKS.

School Formal Leather Shoes must be fully black. Sports shoes must be regular white. No additional colours, whatsoever will be accepted. If the shoes have laces, the laces must be the same plain colour as the shoes. No converse or canvas shoes or boots or pumps will be allowed. We would ask you also not to allow your daughter to wear boys' shoes.

## **SHOES (BOYS)**

BOYS will be allowed to wear sports shoes ( ONLY FULL WHITE ) on the days they have sports and / or co-curricular activities. On other days, all boys MUST wear BLACK FORMAL LEATHER SHOES with NAVY BLUE SOCKS.

School Formal leather shoes must be fully black. Sports shoes must be regular white. No additional colours whatsoever will be accepted. If the shoes have laces, the laces must be the same plain colour as the shoes. No converse or canvas shoes will be allowed.

We would advise parents to buy simple school footwear for their children. This will be more economical for you and will also ensure that the shoes are in keeping with the school regulations.

## **WINTER HOODIE :**

The winter hoodie also continues to be the same.

Kindly note that on those days when students have sports and / or co-curricular activities they **MUST** wear the complete PE uniform and no excuses will be entertained. However, on all other days, students are not permitted to wear the PE uniform or even a combination of it with the regular school uniform. On days when students do not have sports and / or activities, they **MUST** wear the regular school uniform.

All boys **MUST** wear an under- shirt or vest. Kindly note that it **MUST** be **ONLY WHITE** in colour. Similarly, all girls **MUST** wear a vest or camisole that **MUST** be **ONLY WHITE** in colour.

We would also like all parents and students to be aware that uniform infractions will be dealt with very strictly . Students will receive a diary note for a breach of uniform regulations ( this includes the use of accessories, nail polish, hair highlights, tints or colour etc. which is not permitted ). Upon the receipt of three notes for uniform infractions, students will be asked to spend a day home under suspension which will also be reflected in their personal student record.

We appeal to parents to co-operate with us in ensuring that children leave for school in the morning in a uniform which is clean, orderly and worn with dignity. The way the children dress says much about the image of the school, and, quite frankly, the attitude of the children and their level of co-operation, in some cases, has been very disappointing and at times very frustrating. We also appeal to parents to make sure that all students maintain a good sense of personal hygiene and are particular about daily hygiene routines. **PLEASE MAKE SURE THAT NO HAIR COLOUR / TINTING / HIGHLIGHTING IS DONE OVER ANY HOLIDAY BREAKS FOR YOUR CHILD'S HAIR. WE WILL ASK YOU TO HAVE IT REMOVED if this is the case.**

### **Hair and Jewellery : BOYS**

- **Hair should be kept short, combed neat and tidy.**
- No spiked hairstyles allowed; no gel and no tints.
- Boys are not allowed to wear jewellery; except for a simple wristwatch any other item will be confiscated.
- No piercings or tattoos are allowed.

### **Hair and Jewellery : GIRLS**

- Hair must be neatly tied back with a white, navy or black hair-band.
- No coloured tints / or even full hair colour will be allowed. Kindly do not even allow your daughter to tint her hair for festive occasions and / or holidays as she will return to school with the same and that will not be permitted. Artificial hair colour takes a number of months to completely wash out and hence **NO EXCUSES WILL BE ENTERTAINED TO THIS EFFECT.**
- Besides stud earrings and a simple wristwatch, no other jewellery or accessory is allowed.
- No piercings or tattoos are allowed.
- **Students should show respect for their uniform and they are also asked to keep their uniform and their shoes clean and tidy at all times.**

### **PERSONAL HYGIENE :**

Personal hygiene is to be strictly maintained by ALL students and we encourage you dear parents to ensure that students follow a daily routine of bathing and coming to school with their hair neatly combed, their uniform ironed and their appearance fresh and ready to start the school day. Keeping in mind the hot and humid weather conditions prevalent for a major part of the school year, it is advisable for older students to use a light deodorant after sports or outdoor lessons. **It must be noted here that students must not spray these in the classroom as it is often detrimental to some of their classmates who suffer from allergies or asthma.**

### **'Coloured Clothes ' Days**

On occasion, permission is given to students to dress down and wear coloured clothes to school.

Students are asked to observe the following guidelines :

- Headgear of any kind ( i.e. hats, caps, do-rags, bandanas, sweatbands etc. ) may not be worn. Halter, low cut, off-the-shoulder and transparent tops, those with spaghetti straps plus tank tops and muscle ( sleeveless ) shirts are not considered appropriate clothing for the school environment and **MUST NOT BE WORN ON 'COLOURED CLOTHES' DAYS.**
- Tops must be long enough to cover a student's midriff.
- Any clothing displaying an inflammatory slogan, defamatory, suggestive or offensive language, or those promoting illegal activities or products ( i.e. tobacco, drugs or alcohol ) is prohibited.
