Students will draw a diagram to explain how the central and allied powers joined the war.</p> <p>Task- Teacher shows a video on the causes. Students discuss the immediate cause and give reasons for other countries joining the war Students are made to Draw a Diagram showing the reasons for the joining of countries in the war.</p>
