**Greetings from Saint Mary's.** We trust that this update finds you and your families safe and healthy. Please read on for all the latest updates. Information that is still relevant from previous circulars will be referenced from there so that it is not repetitive.

ALL PARENTS PLEASE NOTE THAT THE DEADLINE FOR ALL FIRST TERM FEE PAYMENTS WAS 30<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER. ANY STUDENT WHOSE FIRST TERM FEES HAVE NOT BEEN PAID WILL BE CONSIDERED OUTSTANDING AND WE WILL NOT BE ABLE TO ISSUE CORRECTED ASSESSMENT PAPERS, OFFICIAL DOCUMENTS ETC.

#### 1) EDUCATION PERFECT PASSWORD RE-SET MAILS-PLEASE IGNORE:

It has been brought to our attention that some students have been receiving emails from a platform called EDUCATION PERFECT with a link to change the password. We do not use this platform in our school so we would request you to kindly ignore these emails.

#### 2) MOBILE PHONES ACCEPTABLE USE POLICY -YEARS 12 AND 13:

Parents of Year 12 students are informed that every year, students of Year 12 arrange to have Varsity Jackets bearing the school logo that we permit them to wear instead of the regular winter jacket. Please note that this is entirely a student initiative and there is no obligation for any child to purchase the same. It is completely optional.

Please note that we had sent parents an update on the 27<sup>th</sup> of September about a key change to protocols for masks released by KHDA, effective 28<sup>th</sup> September. Face masks are no longer mandatory

for staff and students while on the premises in private schools but must still be worn on the school buses and other public transport like the metro and public buses etc. We still recommend that children who have underlying health issues or are vulnerable, take precautions by using a face mask.

#### 6) UPDATED COVID-19 PROTOCOLS FROM KHDA:

Parents are requested to kindly view the image below to have a clear picture of the latest Covid-19 protocols released by KHDA. The quarantine period for Covid positive cases is now FIVE days. However, students can only return to school on the sixth day if they are symptom-free. We would like to remind all parents and students to carefully go through this Policy that is available on our school website. The situation that unfolded over the last two years made many children realise, albeit too late the true value of being consistent with their study habits and not waiting until the last minute before exams to prepare and study. It is always best for every child to be **CONSISTENT AND HIGHLY REGULAR** with their study and ensure that they maintain a good level of attainment across all their assessment opportunities and prepare as well as they can for their Board Examinations. This will also help them to achieve better predicted grades as every assessment and examination counts towards the calculation of the same.
