#### Dear Parents,

**Greetings from St. Marys.** The first Parent-Teacher Meeting / Report Day of the academic year will be a wonderful opportunity for you and your children's class teachers to share insightful information about them. The First Parent –Teacher Meeting has been **SCHEDULED** TO *Saturday, 26<sup>TH</sup> November 2022 from 7:30 am until 11:00 am*. All parents are not compelled to attend the meeting and only those parents who wish to meet their children's class teachers may attend. Meeting slots are as follows.

#### Class SIMS ROLL ORDER LIST: Numbers 1-10 (7:30 – 8:30), 11-20 (8:30-9:30), 21-30 (10:00-11:00)

A-Level students will be given a different schedule in class and they will explain to you how that will work. Report cards will be published on the SIMS PARENT APP in advance, however we will not be able to publish report cards of children who have outstanding first term fees. Reports cannot be published if fees are paid at the last minute as the fee deadline was 30<sup>th</sup> September. (For example if fees are paid a few days before the report day, reports cannot be published immediately). Kindly ensure that all outstanding fees are paid immediately if you have not yet done so.

Parents are asked to kindly jot down important points you wish to discuss with your child's class teacher and to not spend more than five minutes with the teacher as a courtesy to other parents. However, if you feel you need to spend a longer time with the class teacher, then it is advisable to make a private appointment with the class teacher at a later date by contacting them via email so they will schedule an appointment based on their availability.

Please send a similar email to any particular subject teacher that you feel you might need to meet personally and a private appointment can be made on another day.
