# **ENGLISH READING:**

Questions will be set on UNSEEN fiction and non-fiction texts - Labels; Lists and Captions; Stories and Information texts.

Multiple choice questions will focus on:

- Vocabulary
- Inference, deduction
- Expressing likes and dislikes
- Sequencing pictures
- Nouns, adjectives, verbs, proper and common nouns and question words.
- Punctuating sentences with capital letters, question marks and full stops.

# ENGLISH WRITING:

### A.SPELLING

For **spelling test**, the teacher will read the words twice and the children will listen carefully. The third time the teacher reads the words, the children will write the word in the blank.

### A range of questions will focus on:

- ➢ Labelling the picture
- Identifying sentence and non sentence
- Rewriting jumbled sentences
- > Writing or Using nouns, proper and common nouns, verbs, adjectives, opposites and questions.
- > Punctuating sentences with capital letters, question marks and full stops.
- Picture description
- Writing a story (story start, middle and end)

#### For writing tasks, marks will be given for:

- Relevant ideas and description, use of suitable vocabulary
- Punctuating sentences with capital letters, full stops, use of correct spelling , and meaningful sentences
- Handwriting
