It is once again important here that ALL PARENTS check your children's digital activity frequently including group activity if your child is part of private groups created by students.

And this year, you will have to write a letter to an author suggesting an alternative 'beginning' to their already published story/book.

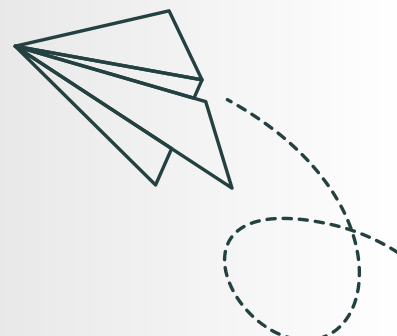
### General guidelines and important dates:
