And this year, you will have to write a letter to an author suggesting an alternative 'beginning' to their already published story/book.

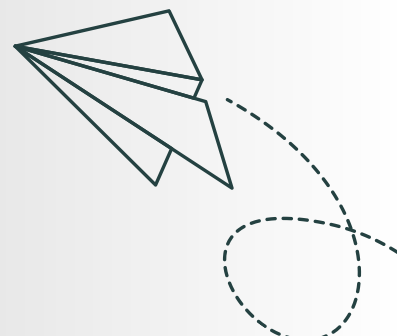
General guidelines and important dates:
