FIRST TERM EXAMINATION -JANUARY 2024

PROSE - The Iron Man (Chapters 1 to 4)

Questions on Prose will assess the students' knowledge, understanding and their responses to the novel. The questions will focus on:

- Deducing and inferring character's actions, thoughts and feelings and supporting them with textual evidence of words and phrases or ideas. (Point, evidence, explanation)
- Sequencing events
- Summarizing main ideas
- Matching events, characters, situations, dialogues of characters
- The beginning and the ending of the chapter 1 - 4
- Writer's point-of-view/s
- Students' response to the story titles, plot development, events, situations and settings in the story; justifying personal response with appropriate reasons

- ***Marks will be given for accurate use of grammar, spelling and punctuation.***

Poetry: Questions will be set on the following list of poems taught.

Questions on Poetry will be set on one or two poems taught in Term 1. They will focus on:

1. Ideas and themes expressed in the poems
2. Identifying the narrator of the poem
3. Understanding the relevance/suitability of the title of the poem
4. Identification and explanation of poetic features with evidence:
 - Simile
 - Metaphor
 - Onomatopoeia
 - Personification
 - Repetition
 - Rhyme
5. Understanding and commenting on meaning of the figurative language.
6. Students' personal response and preferences with evidence and explanation
7. Explanation of poets' use of language with examples of words, phrases.
8. Comparing two poems

Preparation for the examination

- **Reading novels/poems strengthens your critical thinking, builds vocabulary, improves the quality of your answers.**
- **Must re-read the novels, at least three times, carefully and critically with close reference to the focus of questions stated in the portion.**
- **Read the collection of poems in your Poetry text .Write your thoughts, feelings, your likes and dislikes with evidence from the poems. Discuss your reasons and views.**
- **Revise all the work completed in your notebooks, worksheets, GC and your assessments.**
