Our School will be conducting a Science Project Exhibition this year!

The completed project will be due on $22^{\text {nd }}$ April 2024. This is going to be a whole school fair/exhibition wherein every student is encouraged to participate. Students from Year 1 to 6 will work on their task individually and Students from Year 7 to 10 and Year 12 will work in groups assigned by their respective Science teachers.

The due dates have been spread out as to allow ample time for students to complete the work at a steady, but comfortable pace.

The students' work will be assessed out of 20 marks which will be added to the Final Summative average/ marks.

A Science project challenges a student to solve a problem/answer a question using the scientific method or design process.

It is a great way to excite children about Science, teach them to think like Scientists and develop their innovative skills.

All work must be completed by the student. Parents/Guardians can help by offering students support and encouragement, as well as monitor the student's progress in the coming weeks.

It should be noted that a successful project does not have to be expensive. Some of the best projects can be completed using materials found around the home. The project may preferably be a working model.
We encourage students to choose a topic that they are interested in learning more about. Projects should be meaningful and related to real-world experiences.

We are very excited to be hosting our Annual Science exhibition! Top projects from each class will be chosen to be entered in the school exhibition and students will present their work/models.
