- Sequencing events
- Summarizing the key events from the novel
- Matching events, characters, situations, dialogues
- Importance of the opening and the ending of the novel
- writer's point of view with evidence from the novels.
- Students' response to the story titles, events, situations, characters' actions, settings in the story; justifying personal response with appropriate reasons

In Prose, for long or short and long answers, marks will be given for accurate use of grammar, spelling and punctuation.

#### **UNIT 1 – GROUPING LIVING THINGS**

- Common observable characteristics of living things used in sorting and classifying them into different groups.
- Use of simple dichotomous keys to help group, identify and name a variety of living things.
- Compare & Contrast the characteristic features of living things from different habitats.
- Name and describe the characteristics of some new species.

#### **UNIT 2- DANGERS TO LIVING THINGS**

- Changes in environments that can sometimes pose dangers to living things.
- How environments can be changed in positive ways, for example, the creation of nature reserves, and in negative ways, for example, deforestation.
- Construct and interpret a variety of food chains, identifying producers, predators and prey.
- Some ways in which humans can reduce the effects of environmental change/Conservation & protection of living things/Nature reserves etc
- Name and describe the characteristics of some new species.
- Endangered and extinct species.

#### **UNIT 3– ELECTRICITY**

- Common appliances that run on electricity & devices that use batteries that supply electricity.
- Constructing a simple series electrical circuit, identifying and naming its basic parts, including cells, wires, bulbs, switches and buzzers.
- Source of electricity in a circuit and how it works.
- Function of a switch in a circuit.
- Recognise a complete/incomplete circuit and explain the reasoning.
- Electric conductors and insulators.

#### **UNIT 4- CHANGES OF STATE**

- Three states of matter & their properties (solids, liquids and gases).
- Changes in the state of different materials at different temperatures, when they are heated or cooled.
- Reading the temperature in degrees celcius.
- Properties of the three states of water.
- Melting point, Boiling point & Freezing point.
- Explain the terms- Evaporation, Condensation, Precipitation, Boiling & Melting
- Water cycle

#### **UNIT 5 – SOUND**

- The source of a sound and how sound can travel through solids, liquids and gases.
- How vibrations from sounds travel through a medium to the ear& how sound is transmitted from the outer ear to the brain.

- Pitch, Volume and Frequency of sound.
- Identify and describe features of an object that can be changed to alter its pitch, for e.g. length of tube, length of string and tension of string.
- Explain how sounds get fainter as the distance from the sound source increases.
- How some materials are effective in preventing vibrations from sound sources reaching the ear (e.g. Ear muffs).

#### **UNIT 6 – HUMAN NUTRITION**

- Main benefits of each food group, with examples.
- Sequence the process of digestion in humans as ingestion, swallowing, digestion, absorption and egestion.
- Simple functions of the basic parts of the digestive system in humans.
- Different types of teeth in humans and their simple functions.
- Explain what damages the teeth and how to look after them.
- Compare and suggest reasons for the differences in animal teeth Herbivores, Carnivores & Omnivores.
