NEW AND URGENT

- 26th AUGUST 2024 IS THE RE-OPENING DATE FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2024-2025 FOR ALL STUDENTS. Students with re-exams will have to report on 21st August 2024.
- A-LEVEL ADMISSION TO YEAR 12 (2024-2025)- check attachment with admission link.
- GL EXAM UPDATE PT SERIES ONLY COMPATIBLE WITH DESKTOPS OR LAPTOPS
- MOCK EXAM REPORT CARDS YEAR 11 & 13 being issued shortly.

PLEASE NOTE THAT ANY FEES THAT HAVE NOT BEEN PAID ARE NOW CONSIDERED OUTSTANDING. ANY STUDENT WHOSE FEES HAVE NOT BEEN PAID WILL BE CONSIDERED OUTSTANDING AND WE WILL NOT BE ABLE TO ISSUE ANY OFFICIAL SCHOOL DOCUMENTS, EXAMINATION ANSWER SCRIPTS, REPORT CARDS, ETC.

Please note: In cases of outstanding fees, RE-REGISTRATION MUST NOT BE PAID, even if paid, it is not considered as a re-registration but will be adjusted towards the outstanding fees. We urge parents to please be responsible and settle ALL OUTSTANDING fees without any further delay.

The RE-REGISTRATION DEADLINE WAS 21ST APRIL 2024. Any student who has not re-registered will be considered as not returning for the next academic year. This also applies to students with outstanding fees.

- 1) A-LEVEL APPLICATION TO YEAR 12: A link for admission form as well as a letter regarding admissions has been sent out with this circular. Please go through it carefully.
- **2) MOCK EXAM REPORT CARDS -YEARS 11 & 13:** We would like to inform parents that the Mock Exam reports are being sent out over the next few days via the SIMS PARENT APP. Regrettably, we will not be able to send out reports of those students with outstanding fees.
- 3) LITCON (Years 1 to 10 and Year 12): Please see attached circular.
- 4) MODEL UNITED NATIONS (Year 7 Upwards): Please see attached circular.
- 5) EXAMINATION RULES AND REGULATIONS (YEARS 1-10 & Year 12):
 - a) If your child is **very ill** and unable to attend school send an email to the class teacher with the medical certificate informing them of the absence. We will only re-schedule tests that have been missed for this reason. Re-scheduled tests might be scheduled for a Saturday and/or Sunday depending on how many tests have been missed. Please do not keep children at home for minor reasons. Any illness will require a medical certificate for rescheduling a test.

Any absence will require a medical certificate to reschedule the exam, even if the absence is only for ONE DAY. In the absence of a medical certificate, an exam will not be rescheduled, and no marks will be credited for that missed examination.

b) Students must carry their stationery in a transparent plastic case or pouch. No borrowing will be permitted so please ensure that you have the required pens, pencils, erasers and geometry items as needed.

c) NO SMARTWATCHES ALLOWED DURING EXAMINATIONS

- d) Students must not have in their possession any electronic devices to include but not limited to mobile phones, smart watches, tablets, laptops, Bluetooth devices, ipods, mp3/4 players etc. If any of these items are found with a student during a test, they will be given a zero.
- e) Students must not have any unauthorised material during a test notes, chits of paper with written notes, any written notes concealed in the desk or on their person. If any of these are found with a student during a test, they will be given a zero (irrespective of the intent or the lack of it)
- f) Students must not resort to any form of malpractice during a test, they must not speak to any other students during a test. Any form of malpractice will lead to being given a zero for that particular test.
- g) Students writing with pen **MUST ONLY USE A BLACK BALL POINT PEN**.
- h) NO ink erasers, correcting fluid or ink killers are permitted for examinations.
- i) Students must be on time for exams, no extra time will be given to late comers.

6) GL EXAMINATIONS IN ENGLISH LANGUAGE, MATHS & SCIENCE YEARS 4-10 IMPORTANT UPDATE FROM GL EDUCATION - THE GL PT SERIES WILL WORK ONLY ON A DESKTOP OR A LAPTOP therefore parents will be required to send a fully charged laptop on the scheduled days of a GL exam.:. The timetable for these exams has also been included. ALL STUDENTS MUST BE PRESENT ON THE DAY OF A GL EXAM WITH A FULLY CHARGED LAPTOP. Any absence will require a medical certificate to reschedule the exam, even if the absence is only for ONE DAY.

To: Parents of Year Eleven Students Applying for GCE A-Level Two Year Course (YEAR 12 and 13)

Dear Parents,

Greetings from St. Mary's Catholic High School Dubai. We are writing to inform you that the A-LEVEL APPLICATION FORMS are available via the link attached. The last day to submit these forms online is the 16th of June 2024 PLEASE NOTE THAT NO FORM WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THIS DATE.

We would like to point out very clearly that admission to A-Level is not automatic and is a completely new process.

The conditions for a student to be considered for a place in A-Levels are as follows.

SHOULD HAVE AN EXCELLENT BEHAVIOUR RECORD

- 4 SUBJECTS TO BE OPTED FOR and a high-grade average in the same.
- Admissions will be MERIT-BASED.
- Hold a high-grade **average** in all subjects (Internal Exams) in Year Eleven.
- Should have not had any serious or repeated disciplinary issues over Years Nine through Eleven.
- Should not have engaged in activities, in or out of school, which tarnish the reputation of the school.
- Hold a minimum attendance record of 95%.
- Be prepared for an entrance exam in the subject opted for that has not been taken at 0-Level. The portion for the entrance exam is all content covered from Year 9 to Year 11.

We would also like to bring to your attention that under the British system, a student completes high school with the completion of his/her O-Level. Hence the admission to A-Level is then a process of a 'NEW ADMISSION'.

Those students who take Arabic as a First language and Islamic Studies in A-Level will have to maintain a minimum aggregate attendance percentage of 95% for Arabic and / or Islamic Studies lessons, FAILING WHICH STUDENTS WILL NOT BE ISSUED A SCHOOL LEAVING CERTIFICATE/ATTESTED CERTIFICATES OR RECOMMENDATION LETTERS. Students who do not reflect this 95% aggregate attendance after the first month of enrollment might not be allowed to continue the A-Level programme.

Please note that St. Mary's Catholic High School offers the GCE Advanced Levels Linear Programme which means that we DO NOT OFFER **AS LEVEL CERTIFICATION** at the end of Year 12. This is a standalone qualification, and results are declared only at the end of Year 13.

The whole two-year Programme has to be completed for any equivalency certification.

Please consider all the criteria above while making your decision. Parents should also be aware that even if all criteria are met, competition for places remains very stiff as seats are limited and therefore, we strongly recommend that all students should ensure that they have a back-up plan. This would include applying to other institutions besides St. Mary's.

The final deadline for the return of the A-LEVEL application forms is 16th June 2024. Forms will not be accepted after this date, nor will any calls be accepted for the same. Please respect this final deadline.

The list of students selected for VIRTUAL interviews will be posted on the school website after results have been released by Pearson Edexcel in August 2024 and so we advise you to check the school website at that time.



PROPOSED FEE INCREMENT FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2024-2025

Dear Parents,

Greetings from St. Mary's. It is at this time that we wish to provide you with the following information pertaining to a proposed **8%** increase in Tuition Fees, subject to KHDA approval, for the Academic year 2024-2025.

We would like to thank our parent community for your constant support and collaboration. Our mission has always been to provide good quality education that is affordable. Our fee level remains the lowest when compared with other schools that provide the UK Curriculum, a good number of which charge significantly more than St. Mary's.

Cost pressures apply to St. Mary's as much as they do to many other entities and in fact rising costs have impacted our school significantly due to our extremely low fee structure. In spite of diligent financial stewardship and control of expenses, we continually face huge challenges with rising costs with respect to staffing, resources and operational expenses.

We hope you will recognise that our decision to propose an 8% increase in the tuition fees is to sustain the operational needs of the school in supporting its expenses while continuing to provide a good quality education to our children.
