

The due dates have been spread out to allow ample time for students to complete the work at a steady, but comfortable pace.

The students' project will be assessed out of 20 marks. These marks are part of their Final Summative average/marks.

A Science project challenges a student to solve a problem/answer a question using the scientific method or design process.

It is a great way to excite children about Science, teach them to think like Scientists and develop their innovative skills.

All work must be completed by the students. Parents/Guardians can help by offering students support and encouragement, as well as monitor the students' progress in the coming weeks.

It should be noted that a successful project does not have to be expensive. Some of the best projects can be completed using materials found around the home. The project may preferably be a working model.

We encourage students to choose a topic that they are interested in learning more about. Projects should be meaningful and related to real-world experiences.

We are very excited to be hosting our Annual Science exhibition! Top projects from each class will be chosen to be entered in the school exhibition and students will present their work/models.

Thank you in advance for supporting your child in such an exciting process of discovery!

The criteria for assessing the project and other details will be posted on GC by your child's Science teacher and will be discussed during their Science lessons.
