2) RESULTS PLUS ACCOUNT ACTIVATION : Year 11 students have been given the activation code to register their Edexcel Results plus account. We strongly urge you to not delay in activating your account and contact Ms. Vichitra in case you encounter any issues. Later on, the code might not work. Year 13 students have already activated their accounts while in year 11 and therefore are now required to just ensure that the account is still working. In case of any issues , please contact Ms. Vichitra.

Any absence will require a medical certificate to reschedule the exam, even if the absence is only for ONE DAY.**

11) FINAL EXAMINATION : Final Examination Timetables were made available before the Spring Break. Please go through them carefully. **Any absence will require a medical certificate to reschedule the exam, even if the absence is only for ONE DAY. In the absence of a medical certificate, an exam will not be rescheduled, and no marks will be credited for that missed examination.**

12) PORTIONS FOR THE FINAL EXAMINATIONS: We had already uploaded the portions for the Final Examinations on the school website. Teachers have also posted the same on GC.

13) COMPUTING EXAMINATIONS FOR YEARS 2-6: We would like to inform you that since the Computing Exam is a practical exam, it will be conducted during the regular Computing lessons as per the weekly timetable between the 5th and 9th of May 2025. **Any absence will require a medical certificate to reschedule the exam, even if the absence is only for ONE DAY.**

18) PREDICTED GRADES POLICY FOR YEARS 12 & 13 : We would like to remind all parents and students to carefully go through this Policy that is available on our school website. The situation that unfolded over the last few years made many children realise, albeit too late the true value of being consistent with their study habits and not waiting until the last minute before exams to prepare and study. It is always best for every child to be **CONSISTENT AND HIGHLY REGULAR** with their study and ensure that they maintain a good level of attainment across all their assessment opportunities and prepare as well as they can for their Board Examinations. This will also help them to achieve better predicted grades as every assessment and examination counts towards the calculation of the same.

19) SUBJECT CHANGE POLICY , YEARS 9 TO 13: We would like to request all parents of children in these year groups to please go through the Subject Change Policy which is available in the Parents' Info section of the school website.

20) SOCIAL MEDIA FREQUENT CHECKS BY PARENTS FOR SECONDARY & UPPER PRIMARY CHILDREN: Parents of secondary and upper primary children are strongly encouraged to kindly make frequent checks of your child's use of social media. We have seen in

many cases that minor children are being sought out on Instagram, Snapchat and other platforms by much older individuals for chats and conversations. It is important for parents to know who their children are conversing with to protect them from any potential safeguarding issues. We would also like to remind parents about your children's use of inappropriate content and language on Social Media Platforms which you will be aware of only if you make frequent checks of the same. Please have your child remove himself/herself from private social media groups that are not encouraged or recommended by us at St. Mary's. The school cannot take responsibility for private groups started by students, and we strongly discourage the formation of these groups as well as discourage student participation in them. It is once again important here that ALL PARENTS check your children's digital activity frequently including group activity if your child is part of private groups created by students.

21) STUDENT ABSENCES MUST BE INFORMED BY PARENTS: All parents are requested to kindly inform the class teacher via email whenever a child is absent, even if it is just for one day. A simple email with the reason for the absence will suffice but is mandatory. Unaccounted for absences will be marked as unjustified and will be reflected on students' progress reports.

22) NO FEE PAYMENTS MUST BE DEPOSITED INTO THE SCHOOL ACCOUNT: Parents are reminded that fee payments MUST not be deposited into the school account. Kindly come to school if you wish to pay fees in cash so that we can issue the fee receipt immediately.
