Students will be assessed for reading comprehension, spelling, grammatical awareness, and creative writing skills.

Reading: Comprehension questions will be set on an extract from an unseen story and an unseen non-fiction text.

Questions will focus on:

- Identifying and retrieving key words, phrases, ideas, information about setting, events, characters from texts
- Differentiation between fact and opinion
- Deducing and inferring meanings of words, phrases, ideas, information, character's actions, thoughts and feelings with evidence from texts
- Identifying and explaining presentational features, language features, punctuation, figures of speech, atmosphere, mood and tone in texts
- Identifying audience/purpose of texts
- Sequencing ideas, events in the correct order.
- Summarizing key ideas

Writing: Questions will focus on spellings, grammar, and creative writing.

B. Grammar:

- Word Class
- Adverbs & Adverbials
- Modal verbs
- Formal and Informal Language
- Tense (present tense/ past tense/ progressive tenses/perfect tenses)
- Apostrophes (contractions and possessives)

C. Creative Writing question will focus on:

a. Forms of non-fiction texts for writing:

- Writing a newspaper article
- Writing an argument text
- Writing a balanced argument
- Writing a Recount

b. Writing a short story with an effective opening, complication, resolution and ending, incorporating speech, action and description to sustain the interest of the reader.

Questions will assess students’ knowledge of the novel and short stories; understanding of the novel and short stories and their response to them.

A range of questions such as multiple choice, short answer and long answer questions will focus on:

- Exploration of features of stories such as openings and endings.
- Plot development-significance of events, situations and character development.
- Characters’ reactions to events/situations and interaction between characters.
- Themes and their importance
- Writer’s use of language and style
- Students’ response to the novel, stories: characters, events, situations, setting, plot, theme, point of view, writer’s style, writer's techniques.
- Comparing characters, events and stories.
- Justifying own opinions with textual evidence.

Section B –POETRY

15 Marks

Range of questions will be set on **two unseen poems**.

Questions will focus on:

- Ideas and themes expressed in the poems;
- Interpretation of poet's viewpoints
- Comparison of ideas, themes, poets' viewpoints
- Poet's use of language, form and structure to create effect
- Descriptive and narrative effects
- Personal responses and preferences, supported by reference to poems
- Identification and explanation of poetic features with evidence. The following poetic features in particular can be studied:
 - a) Onomatopoeia
 - b) Simile
 - c) Metaphor
 - d) Personification
 - e) Alliteration
 - f) Rhyme

Accurate use of grammar, spelling and punctuation will also be considered.

Preparation for the Examination

- Enjoy reading the Literature texts. It is a reflection of life.
- Reading novels/poems strengthens your critical thinking, builds vocabulary, and improves the quality of your answers.
- Must re-read the novel carefully and critically with close reference to the focus of questions stated in the portion.
- Read the collection of poems in your poetry text with close reference to the focus of questions stated in the portion. Write your thoughts, feelings, your likes and dislikes with evidence from the poems. Discuss your reasons and views.
- Revise all the work completed in your notebooks, resource files, your assessments and tests.
