Dear Parents, Staff and our dear Students,

Greetings from St. Mary's. We trust that this update finds you all safe and well. Please be assured of our prayers and best wishes for each and every member of our Marian Family.

For tomorrow, Tuesday, the 3rd of March 2026, please find below, instructions for what remote learning will look like at our school.

Attendance Registration mandatory for all (please check well in advance that any network issues are resolved) - only via a live Zoom link for all students from Year 1 to Year 13 at 7:10 am sharp until 7:25 am. Please note that every single student will have to identify themselves via the Zoom link, live on camera to their class teachers in order for them to be marked present for the day. This is also applicable to Year 13 students, who sometimes attend on site lessons later if they do not have the first lesson in the morning.

This morning's registration is also going to be used as a well-being check in so that class teachers can talk to their students to ensure that they are safe and well.

YEARS 11, 12 and 13

- Live Synchronous lessons for ALL lessons of the day are applicable to Years 11, 12 and 13.
- Teachers will send them a zoom link in their subject GC.

YEARS 9 and 10

- Live Synchronous Lessons are applicable to students of Years 9 and 10 for the following lessons:
 - Mathematics, Arabic, English Language, all Science and all Commerce subjects.
- Asynchronous lessons for subjects not mentioned above with work posted in GC which MUST be turned in before the end of the lesson.

YEARS 1-8

- Asynchronous lessons for Years 1 - 8 according to the day's timetable and lesson timings.
- Subject teachers will post relevant work in the Google classroom according to the timetable for tomorrow.
- Students from Years 7 and 8 will have to turn in the work before the end of the lesson.
- For Students from Years 1 to 6, this work will be checked by their teachers when they return to on-site learning.

We appeal to parents to ensure that children are attending required lessons and that they are maintaining respectful standards of behaviour online.

The ICT and computer science mock examinations for Year 11 will be rescheduled to a later date which we will only be able to inform you once we are directed to a better understanding of the current situation.
