Dear Parents,

Greetings from St. Mary's. Firstly, we would like to extend our sincere gratitude for your patience and support regarding the impact of the current situation on the students' examinations. We understand that constant changes do have an impact on the children and their wellbeing and we are doing our best to mitigate these, however, there are many factors beyond our control.

In light of current regional developments, KHDA are continuing to assess the situation in coordination with the relevant authorities. They will be communicating directives on whether schools will continue distance learning or resume on-site learning **on Sunday, May 10**.

Schools have been asked to remain prepared to implement the directives communicated **from Monday, May 11**, immediately. The safety and wellbeing of students, staff, and the wider education community remain our top priority.

Regardless of the learning model communicated (distance or on-site), all examinations will be conducted on site in accordance with the Ministry of Education's protocols for on-site examinations during this period

This means that ALL students will have to answer examinations on-site irrespective of the learning model declared.

Schools must seek approval for this purpose and submit an emergency response plan in line with the protocols as well as a host of other related documentation.

In-line with the time frame given to us we will not schedule any examinations on Monday and Tuesday 11th and 12th of May respectively. This is being done keeping in mind that approval will have a timeline and we do not want to keep our students guessing until the last minute.

PLEASE FIND THE UPDATED TIMETABLE AS PER THE NEW DEVELOPMENT. We have tried our best to keep student WELLBEING in mind. We will be considering a weighted average for some of the non-core subjects and some of their work portfolios.
