Greetings from St. Mary's Catholic High School. It has been an engaging year for all the families who belong to our larger Marian Family and we would like to take this opportunity to say a heartfelt thank you to all of our children, our parents and our teachers and staff for your extraordinary collaboration and support and your positivity throughout this year. We understand that times have not been easy and we are hopeful for better days ahead for all of our Marian Family. Please read on for important information and updates. **WE REQUEST ALL PARENTS TO CHECK THE WEBSITE REGULARLY FOR ANY URGENT UPDATES.**

1) OUTSTANDING FEES AT THIS JUNCTURE OF THE ACADEMIC YEAR: We have sent parents several reminders in all of our weekly circulars as well as by email. We would like to finally remind parents that students with outstanding fees at the end of the Academic Year are considered as not registered for the new Academic Year 2026-2027. **Please ensure that ALL OUTSTANDING DUES ARE SETTLED BEFORE WE CLOSE THIS YEAR ON 6 JULY 2026.**

2) RE-REGISTRATION FOR THE NEXT ACADEMIC YEAR 2026-2027: We have been following up on re-registrations over the last two and a half months and would like to thank those parents who have respected these deadlines. Parents who have not re-registered their children for the next Academic Year including those whose children have outstanding fees must understand that they will be removed from the system and those seats will have to be made available to new applicants.

3) FEES FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2026-2027: We will publish the fee table of applicable fees on the school website. We are still awaiting official and approved fee structure for 2026-2027 from KHDA.

4) TEXT BOOK ORDERS AND COLLECTION FOR THE NEXT ACADEMIC YEAR 2026-2027: We had sent a separate circular detailing how book orders are to be made. The deadline for placing orders was 01 July 2027. MOE has only just made available pricing and this is now available from Novelhouse, parents are requested to please check the same.

5) RE-OPENING FOR THE NEXT ACADEMIC YEAR 2026-2027: The Academic Year will begin on the **31st of August 2026** for all students from years One through Thirteen. **School timings are 7:10 am until 1:50 pm. All students MUST BE ON THE PREMISES BY 7:05 AM.**

6) BUILDING OUR FUTURE STARS: Parents of students who had registered for this programme are notified that since we could not complete the programme due to the regional conflict, we will be commencing this programme with the same students from 25th September. We will send you further communication when we return for the next academic year.

7) SCHOOL OFFICE CLOSURE: The school office will be open on 4th and 6th July 2026. The last working day for the office is 6th July 2026. **The office timings for 6th July will be from 7:30 to 10:30 am.** The office closure includes emails to all members of the school's leadership and administration as well. The administration office will re-open on 13th August 2026. Please note that those parents who clear outstanding fee dues during the period of office closure will receive receipts and report cards only once the office resumes.

Parents of New Admissions, however, must continue to email copies of the Leaving/Transfer Certificate as soon as you receive it from your child's school. Email these copies only to: arabicsec-smchs@smgeducation.org

8) PEARSON EDEXCEL RESULTS FOR YEARS 11, 12 (IAS) AND YEAR 13 AND EXIT SURVEY: Students from Year 13 and Year 11 will tentatively receive their results in August 2026. Parents are advised to kindly follow to check the school website for further updates on Pearson Edexcel Results.

All Year 11 students will be sent a link in their email to generate their Results Plus passwords so as to access their results in August 2026. When you generate your password, please use your personal email ID and not the school email ID.

The Exit Survey for ALL Years 11 and 13 students is a compulsory requirement from KHDA. Please ensure that your child completes the exit survey without further delay. They have been sent the survey link.

9) EXTRA LESSONS (SATURDAYS) YEAR 13 STUDENTS: Parents are requested to kindly see the attached circular.

10) School Uniform:

Please check the attached **SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY** and circular for **PROCEDURAL GUIDELINES** for the purchase of school uniforms in August 2026.

SCHOOL SHOES: Following on from a lot of requests from parents about having access to good quality school shoes and PE shoes at affordable rates, we have tied up with a very reliable brand to have these available during the week we have distribution of the uniforms and books. **Please see the attached flyer.**

11) BOARD EXAMINATION FEES: We would like you to be informed well in advance that PEARSON EDEXCEL BOARD EXAMINATION FEES will be collected in the month of **NOVEMBER 2026** for students in Years ELEVEN and THIRTEEN. We trust that this will help you to budget accordingly. You can check your KHDA Parent-School contract for the BOARD EXAM FEE AMOUNT for each year group.

12) RECOMMENDATION LETTERS: Parents whose children require recommendation letters from teachers are reminded that these will only be available after 26th August 2026.

13) APPLICATIONS FOR LEAVING CERTIFICATES YEARS 1-10 & YEAR 12: While we have already issued Leaving Certificates to parents who had requested for these, please note that additional requests for **LEAVING CERTIFICATES** must be now made after 13th August 2026. Leaving Certificates cannot be issued during the period of office closure.

14) APPLICATIONS FOR LEAVING CERTIFICATES YEARS 11 & 13: Parents of students in Years 11 and 13 are reminded that Leaving Certificates must be applied for but can be issued only after Pearson Edexcel Results are issued in August 2026. Please note that the process is not immediate as results must be approved by KHDA. Students in Years 11 and 13 have to apply for a leaving Certificate by filling out the form available on the school website.

15)APPROVED KHDA CALENDAR FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2026-2027:

We are still awaiting approval from KHDA for the Academic Calendar 2026-2027.

Parents are requested to check the approved KHDA School Calendar for the Academic Year 2026-2027 that will be sent to you when we receive it. This will help you plan. Please note that only emergency medical / bereavement leave will be approved during school days. This leave should be reasonable in nature and commensurate to the medical or bereavement situation. Leave for family holidays and celebrations must coincide with the school holidays as per the KHDA calendar.

Leave from school for events like, but not limited to graduations, weddings, parties, anniversary celebrations etc will not be granted during school days and if absences like this occur during exams, there will be no re-exams in that case. We expect parents to respect these dates and not request leave during school days.

16) GL AND NGRT TEST RESULTS: Parents are reminded that the GL and NGRT (Cycle C) test results have been sent to your child's school email ID.

17) ORIENTATION FOR PARENTS AND NEW STUDENTS OF YEARS ONE, TWO THREE & FOUR (This is applicable only to newly admitted students for the

next academic year): There will be an Orientation Meeting before the start of the Academic Year on 24th August 2026 in the MAIN HALL at

7:15 am sharp. You will be given some orientation about the school's expectations from parents. You will also be introduced to your child's class teacher, and you will have the opportunity to settle any doubts you might have.

Re: **CLARIFICATIONS REGARDING UNIFORM
POLICY FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2026 – 2027**

Dear Parents,

Please read through the Uniform Policy carefully.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

Girls' Shirt:

All girls will continue to wear the light blue blouse with the school logo. **We request parents to kindly make sure that the size selected for your daughter is appropriate with a slightly looser fit for a more modest appearance.**

Girls' Skirt :

Girls will also continue to wear the existing grey skirt, but we would like to appeal to all parents to make sure that the skirts purchased for your daughter are worn modestly and are of appropriate length (must cover the knees while seated). **It has been an unpleasant experience to have to constantly correct our young ladies for the often-immodest length of their skirts and we strongly urge all parents to take strict cognizance of the same and to ensure that your daughters' skirts are well below the knee. Do take into account sudden gains in height when you purchase skirts. Blouses should also be comfortable in their fit and not too tight fitting.**

Boys' Uniform :

Boys will also continue to wear the white T-Shirt with the school logo and navy-blue trousers.

Boys' and Girls' Sports Uniform :

Boys and girls throughout the school will wear dark navy blue track pants and a T-shirt in their respective colours with the house logo on the back and the school logo in front. *It is highly recommended that children have at least two sets of sports uniforms to allow for time to have these washed when sports lessons might be on consecutive days.*

SHOES (GIRLS):

GIRLS will be allowed to wear sports shoes (ONLY FULL WHITE) on the days they have sports. On other days, all girls MUST wear BLACK SHOES with GREY SOCKS. **BLACK SHOES MAY BE FORMAL OR EVEN SPORTS SHOES.** In the past we used to mandate only formal shoes but after suggestions from parents and students about comfort and practicality, we will accept black sports shoes as well. A white sole will also be permitted but there must not be any other colour or design on the shoes.

Sports shoes must be **regular white**. No additional colours, whatsoever, will be accepted. If the shoes have laces, the laces must be the same plain colour as the shoes. **No converse or canvas shoes or boots will be allowed.** We would ask you also not to allow your daughter to wear boys' shoes.

Shoes with high block heels are also not permitted due to tripping hazards or the potential danger of mistakenly stamping another person's foot with high-heeled shoes.

SHOES (BOYS):

BOYS will be allowed to wear sports shoes (ONLY FULL WHITE) on the days they have sports. On other days, all boys MUST wear BLACK SHOES with NAVY BLUE

SOCKS. BLACK SHOES MAY BE FORMAL OR EVEN SPORTS SHOES. In the past we used to mandate only formal shoes but after suggestions from parents and students about comfort and practicality, we will accept black sports shoes as well. A white sole will also be permitted but there must not be any other colour or design on the shoes.

Sports shoes must be **regular white**. No additional colours, whatsoever, will be accepted. If the shoes have laces, the laces must be the same plain colour as the shoes. **No converse or canvas shoes or boots will be allowed.**

We would advise parents to buy simple school footwear for your children. This will be more economical for you and will also ensure that the shoes are in keeping with the school regulations.

WINTER HOODIE:

The winter hoodie also continues to be the same. Year 12 and 13 students are allowed to wear their school Varsity jackets and those students on the school sports teams are allowed to wear the school sports team jacket.

Kindly note that on those days when students have sports, they **MUST** wear the complete PE uniform, and no excuses will be entertained. However, on all other days, students are not permitted to wear the PE uniform or even a combination of it with the regular school uniform. On days when students do not have sports, they **MUST** wear the regular school uniform.

All boys **MUST** wear an under- shirt or vest. Kindly note that it **MUST** be **ONLY WHITE** in colour. Similarly, all girls **MUST** wear a vest or camisole that **MUST** be **ONLY WHITE** in colour.

We would also like all parents and students to be aware that uniform infractions will be dealt with very strictly. Parents will receive an email for a breach of uniform regulations (this includes the use of accessories, nail polish, hair highlights, tints or colour etc. which is not permitted). Three uniform infractions will result in students being asked to spend a day home under suspension which will also be reflected in their personal student record.

We appeal to parents to co-operate with us in ensuring that children leave for school in the morning in a uniform which is clean, orderly and worn with dignity. The way the children dress says much about the image of the school, and, quite frankly, the attitude of the children and their level of co-operation, in some cases, have been very disappointing and at times very frustrating. We also appeal to parents to make sure that all students maintain a good sense of personal hygiene and are particular about daily hygiene routines. **PLEASE MAKE SURE THAT NO HAIR COLOUR / TINTING / HIGHLIGHTING IS DONE OVER ANY HOLIDAY BREAKS FOR YOUR CHILD'S HAIR. WE WILL ASK YOU TO HAVE IT REMOVED if this is the case.**

Hair and Jewellery : BOYS

- **Hair should be kept short, combed neat and tidy. Hair must not cover the forehead at all and must be well off the collar, ears and face. Hair must in no way compromise vision.**
- No spiked hairstyles allowed, no gel and no tints. Extreme styles—such as mohawks, mullets, shaved lines, ridges, or extreme skin fades—are not permitted. Hair must be of a natural color. The use of unnatural highlighters, dyes, or colorful/exaggerated gels, waxes, and mousses is strictly prohibited.
- Boys are not allowed to wear jewellery; except for a simple wristwatch, any other item will be confiscated.
- No piercings or tattoos are allowed. Jewellery of religious significance may be pinned on the inside of the school shirt or around a chain underneath the school shirt and must not be visible.

Hair and Jewellery : GIRLS

- Hair must be neatly tied back with a white, navy blue or black hair tie.
- **No coloured tints / or even full hair colour will be allowed. Kindly do not even allow your daughter to tint her hair for festive occasions and / or holidays as she will return to school with the same and that will not be permitted. Artificial hair colour takes a number of months to completely wash out and hence NO EXCUSES WILL BE ENTERTAINED TO THIS EFFECT.**
- Besides stud earrings and a simple wristwatch, no other jewellery or accessories are allowed. The earrings must only be worn in the regular lower earlobe area and not on any other part of the ear. Long dangling earrings are not permitted because they pose a hazard if they get hooked onto anything that could result in injury to the earlobe.

- No piercings or tattoos are allowed. Jewellery of religious significance may be pinned on the inside of the school shirt or around a chain underneath the school shirt and must not be visible.

Students should show respect for their uniform, and they are also asked to keep their uniform and their shoes clean and tidy at all times.

PERSONAL HYGIENE:

Personal hygiene is to be strictly maintained by ALL students, and we encourage you dear parents to ensure that students follow a daily routine of bathing and coming to school with their hair neatly combed, their uniform ironed and their appearance fresh and ready to start the school day. Keeping in mind the hot and humid weather conditions prevalent for a major part of the school year, it is advisable for older students to use a light deodorant after sports or outdoor lessons. **It must be noted here that students must not spray this in the classroom as it is often detrimental to some of their classmates who suffer from allergies or asthma.**

‘Coloured Clothes’ Days

On occasion, permission is given to students to dress down and wear-coloured clothes to school. Students are asked to observe the following guidelines :

- Headgear of any kind (i.e. hats, caps, bandanas, sweatbands etc.) may not be worn. Halter, low cut, off-the-shoulder and transparent tops, those with spaghetti straps plus tank tops and muscle (sleeveless) shirts are not considered appropriate clothing for the school environment and **MUST NOT BE WORN ON ‘COLOURED CLOTHES’ DAYS.**
- Tops must be long enough to cover a student’s midriff.
- Any clothing displaying an inflammatory slogan, defamatory, suggestive or offensive language, or those promoting illegal activities or products (i.e. tobacco, drugs or alcohol) is prohibited.
- **Students who fail to observe these guidelines will not be allowed to attend classes and parents will be called to school to either bring in appropriate clothing or to take the child home. Please read the attached Coloured Clothes Day Policy.**



COLOURED CLOTHES DAY DRESS CODE

Together with the School's Senior Student Council, we have arrived at a Coloured Clothes Day Dress Code as a ready reference for both Parents and Teachers to have a clear idea of what is not acceptable for any student of the school to wear whenever the school invites students' to wear coloured clothes or on days like 'Ethnic Day', 'Talent Show' etc. We have worked with the Students Council following suggestions from parents, students, teachers and our experiences with some instances of inappropriate clothing on 'Coloured Clothes Days.' We would like our students to enjoy these days in a responsible manner.

IT IS NOT PERMITTED for ANY STUDENT TO WEAR THE FOLLOWING:

GIRLS

Any shorts, dress, skirt that is above the knee (All clothing must be below the knee)

No Jeans/ trousers that are RIPPED/ DISTRESSED above the knee

No RIPPED/ DISTRESSED Tights

No see-through/ transparent blouses/ t-shirts / dresses

No fish net / lace stockings (SIMPLE OPAQUE COLOURED STOCKINGS ONLY)

No off-shoulder tops/ blouses/ dresses/ any upper body wear

No low necklines

No upper body wear/ blouses/ tops/ t-shirts that are midriff revealing

No strappy/ spaghetti strapped tops/ blouses/ vests/ t-shirts/ dresses

No backless or strapped 'cholis' (worn with a sari)

No tattoos and extra piercings (other than earrings)

BOYS

No tank t-shirts (sleeveless t-shirts that are deeply cut in)

No inappropriate signs or slogans on clothing

No piercings and tattoos

No shorts above the knee (Short Pants must be below the knee)

Any student found not complying with the above will be kept in a private office area until a parent (who will be contacted) brings in some appropriate clothing.
